Virginia Tech Distance and Extended Campus Program Delivery

As the Commonwealth's senior land grant university, Virginia Tech's mission includes the delivery of courses, programs and services throughout the state. Virginia Tech operates and delivers programs of study to seven extended campuses and centers, four of which are shared with other Virginia Universities. In addition, the University delivers programs of study to thirteen accredited colleges and university campuses and centers and many public school systems across the state. Further, Virginia Tech delivers programs to government sites and selected businesses and industries. Finally, through the use of technology, the University delivers programs of study to students' homes.

The University has used and will continue to use a variety of instructional delivery methods to extend its on-grounds offerings. These methods include:

- faculty in a face-to-face environment at extended sites
- faculty in a live two-way interactive video conferencing environment at extended sites
- faculty in a live one-way video, two-way audio satellite television environment at extended sites
- faculty in a videotaped/CD-ROM environment at extended sites and student homes
- faculty in a computer assisted instructional environment at extended sites
- faculty in an interactive online environment over the Internet at extended sites and students home

The following Distance Education and Extended Campus Program Matrix lists programs of study by college offered at a distance and to extended campuses and sites. Included in this matrix is the program area, the first year offered and the current contact person. Also included is the certificate or degree offered and the location where offered. Locations are grouped into six categories: Virginia Tech extended campuses or sites, other higher education sites, government sites, business and industry sites, K-12 public school sites, and students' home.
